Department Spotlight

Infrastructure Development Division



In this issue we will shed some light on the Infrastructure Development Division; part of the Engineering & Planning Department. Engineer Imad Qotom, Head of Infrastructure Division answered our questions and helped us more understand his division's role in the development of the Amman Civil Airport.

Q: Name a project that you have worked on that you consider your pride and joy and why?

A: Our work is categorized into two stages, stage one which is the studies and design and stage two is the tendering and construction. The project that I consider a special one for me is the rehabilitation of the departures terminal at the Amman Civil Airport. The reason for that is that the project contains renovation for the current terminal hall and also includes a super finished new terminal that meets the International standards and requirements of most International airports.

Q: What are the current projects the Infrastructure division are working on?

A: We are currently working on a case study for the rehabilitation of the airside field that includes aprons and runways. This project requires around 2 months to complete and we hope that this project will be implemented during the first quarter of 2017.

Q: What are the future projects that the Infrastructure division aims to achieve?

A: We have several projects that we intend to work on in the future, some of which include but are not limited to:

- A Car Parking Building.
- A New Airport Apron.
- The New Extension of the Arrival's Terminal.

Q: In your opinion what are the main challenges that the Infrastructure division face?

A: Our Main challenge is finishing our projects on time as we face lots of challenges during the work phases, however I am always very optimistic as we have high caliber employees working together as a team who strive to overcome challenges and obstacles faced together.
